### Quillows – Basic Sewing Class

A quillow is a quilted throw that folds up into a pillow. This class is suitable for beginners and experienced with sewing. You will need to bring 2.5 yards of printed cotton or cotton blend fabric, and 2.5 yards of a solid color fabric for the backing (which may be made of cotton or flannel). To prevent shrinkage and fading, please wash fabrics and dry in dryer before bringing them to class. You will also need batting for a twin sized quilt and “Dual Duty Plus” all purpose thread. If you are unable to bring your sewing machine, please let me know. Scissors, pins, tape measures, and irons/ironing boards provided. Max. class is 8 students, Teen to Adults.

## Woodland Indian Strap Dress

The strap dresses are original to Woodland Indian people and were created in the early 1900s from Trade Goods. The version you will be making is for the Reservation Era using 100% cotton velveteen and silk ribbons. The workshop begins with a historical view followed by pattern making and then strap dress creation. Both the dress and sleeves will be sewn in class using sewing machines and/or hand sewing. Students must be intermediate seamstresses or tailors (experienced in basic hand sewing, beading, and using a sewing machine). Students may bring their own sewing basket of tools and/or their sewing machines. Max. students 8. Adults (teens allowed if they are experienced in sewing). No children allowed in the workshops. Participants are encouraged to bring a bag lunch and beverage for the lunch break. Beadwork design may vary from image shown.

The black velveteen, cotton duck fabric, and cordage for the dress as well as basic sewing supplies will be included in the class fee. More info provided by mail to students before the start of the workshop.
