Value of Service

All children 12 years old and older are welcome to apply. The Oneida Arts program will be compensating all of our mentors and coaches. We only ask that the family acknowledge our teachers in a traditional meaning of exchange at the families discretion.

Social Celebration

Performance for the completion of the program will be a social celebrating what our children have accomplished. It will be up to the family to set the date for the participant to present the knowledge they have learned. We are asking that the child have at least 9 months to prepare. The family can schedule a date anytime after 90% of program is complete. We ask that the family limit the social celebration to one rescheduling if necessary. Social will be held at facility of the family's choice.

Coaching

Parents will have to schedule a meeting with facilitators to set up a schedule to meet with mentors and practice. During this meeting the family will be given the materials with modules that will need to be completed before the child is able to have their Social Celebration.
